Wesley has been a home away from home for many students through mutual support, small group ministries, Bible studies, and the developing of strong, lasting friendships. We have a special relationship with the members of Cullowhee United Methodist Church. They feel it is their joy and privilege to get to know the college students who come to Wesley. They often "adopt" students to give them a family away from home, attend Wesley mission trips, and cook meals for hungry students. We are not only physically connected but connected in so many other ways!

What Happens at the Wesley Foundation?

Wesley's space is like a home. It has a lounge space for watching TV, hanging out on the couches, meeting with friends, and doing school work. It has a large room for eating,

playing games, doing group projects, and our weekly worship service "Whee Worship."



There's a kitchen where our Thursday night meal is prepared, student's can prepare their own meals, and where students can help themselves to leftovers. It has an office for the campus minister where students stop by to say hello, hang a while on the couch, or to talk. Lastly, there is the covered bridge where students can often be found hanging out socializing, eating, or holding a small group activity.

What Else?

More than a place for hanging out, studying, eating, and worshipping; the Wesley Foundation is a group of students who may or may not be like each other but find they have a common bond and become friends for life.
